DRESS FOR SAFETY

THE ARROYO VISTA CHARTER SCHOOL DRESS FOR SAFETY POLICY IS AS FOLLOWS:

- Tops:** Shirts/Blouses **must have sleeves**. Acceptable tops include polo shirts, turtle-necks, tee shirts, blouses and collared shirts.
- Bottoms:** Long pants or shorts, fitted at the waist. Shorts must be appropriate for school. Not too tight or too short.
- Hats:** The only hat that is permissible is a baseball-type cap without any offensive language.
- Shoes:** Shoes must be closed-toed and appropriate for P.E. activities.

CLOTHING THAT IS NOT ALLOWED:

- **Spaghetti straps, tank tops and bare midriffs are not acceptable**
- Apparel with logos, pictures, writing or other insignia, which is crude, vulgar, profane and/or sexually suggestive, or has “**put downs**”, or which advertises or advocates racial, ethnic or religious prejudice, or the use of drugs, tobacco or alcohol is prohibited
- No oversized clothing, flannel shirts, starter jackets
- No low-rise pants that expose underwear
- No short shorts
- No mini skirts
- No open toed shoes or heels
